Dear Residents and Business Owners,

The City of Frontenac has been informed by MoDOT that the intersection of Lindbergh and German Boulevard will undergo repaving starting June 30, weather permitting. The initial plan to close Lindbergh has been revised to include lane closures and temporary traffic rerouting, minimizing the impact on residential streets and local businesses as much as possible.

The project is expected to last three weeks, with lane closures for paving each week. Attached is a map from MoDOT detailing the lane closures. The work will be completed in three phases:

Phase #1 – Removal and replacement of the right turn lane on German Boulevard.

Phase #2 – Removal and replacement of the left turn/thru lane and median strip.

Phase #3 – Removal and replacement of the westbound entrance to German Boulevard.

We understand this project may cause some disruption, but this is the schedule provided to us by MoDOT.
